Rhema

That which is spoken, what is uttered in speech or writing.

“Baptizo”: To baptize, primarily a frequentative form of bapto “to dip” used among the Greeks to signify the dyeing of a garment, or the drawing of water by dipping a vessel into another. It can also be used to symbolize the washing of oneself.
