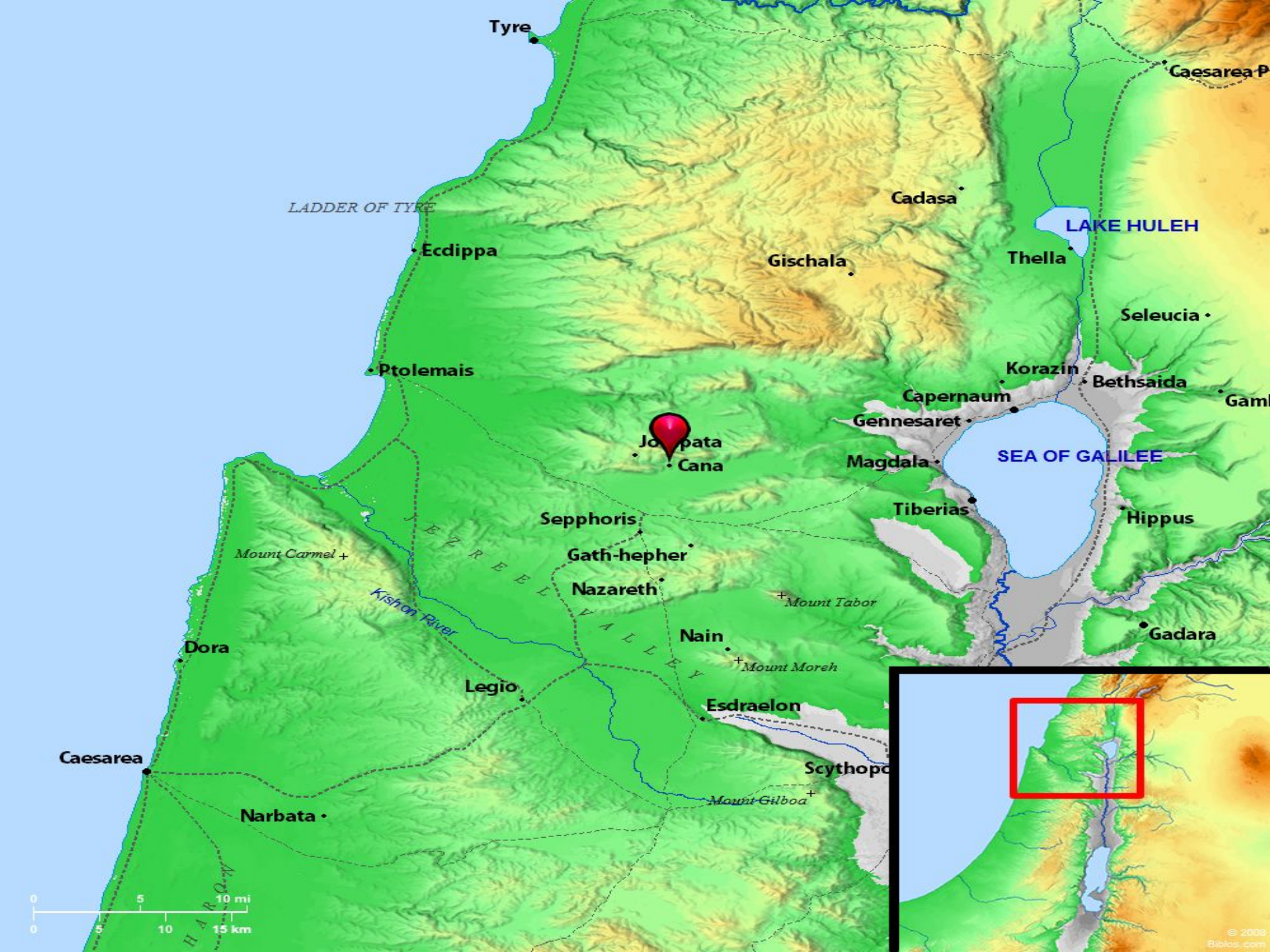

So, what is the passover?

- Jews selected the lamb on the tenth of the month
- Celebrated passover on the 14th day of the lunar month of Nisan (full moon at the end of Mar. or beginning of April.)
- They slaughtered the lamb between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m. on the night of the feast.
- Passover commemorates the deliverance of the Jews from slavery in Egypt when the death angel “passed over” Jewish homes in Egypt whose doorposts were sprinkled with the blood.
